

This is the letter **KHAPH SOFIT**: **ך** (כַּף סּוֹפִית)

It goes below the line. This shape is only found at the end of a word.

It looks a little like someone bending over to be sick (KH...)

It sounds like **KH** (like you are clearing your throat, preparing to spit). It represents the number 20.

It is the only final letter that always has a vowel mark in it. It will either have a Resting SH'VA or a QAMATZ in it.

Practice reading the consonant **KHAPH SOFIT** with all the vowels. Use the sound file from the website to hear the sounds:
