

This is the letter **SHIN**: ש (שין)

The letter SHIN means “tooth” and it makes the sound of “**SHooSHing**” air between the front teeth. Note that the dot is on the right, which can remind you of the right part of the word sun**SH**ine. Some people remember that “**SH**e is always right.”

It sounds like **SH**. SHIN represents the number 300.

Practice reading the letter SHIN with all the vowels. You can use the sound file from the website to hear the sounds:
