

This is the letter **YOD**: י (יוד)

It is the most teen**Y** tin**Y** letter. **Y**ou use it a lot like the letter **Y**.

It sounds like **Y**. It represents the number 10.

YOD is often used as part of a vowel. Sometimes it is used like this: יְ (Hiriq Maleh = “ee”).

It can also be used for other vowel sounds, such as: יִ (sounds like a long “I” as in “aye”);

יֵ (sounds like “ey” as in “they”).

Practice reading the consonant YOD with all the vowels. Use the sound file from the website to hear the sounds:
