

## Paradigm for Perfect Last Root Letter is א

אָנִי	אָנִי	אָנִי	אָנִי
אָתָּה	אָתָּה	אָתָּה	אָתָּה
אָתָּן	אָתָּן	אָתָּן	אָתָּן
הוּא	הוּא	הוּא	הוּא
הִיא	הִיא	הִיא	הִיא

1 represents the first root letter of a verb (פ' הפועל)

2 represents the second/middle root letter of a verb (ע' הפועל)

3 represents the third/last root letter of a verb (ל"א)

Note that the aleph often has no vowel under it
