

שלים לובול the Yiddish word for a spinning top with four Hebrew letters representing the four words for the Hebrew phrase: a Great Miracle Happened There. In Hebrew the words are מס בּרוֹל הָיָה שָׁם Nes Gadol Hayah Sham. The Hebrew word for Dreidel is מֵס בְּרוֹל הָיָה שָׁם Nes Gadol Hayah Poh). The miracles of Hanukkah include the few simple Jews defeating the Greek-Syrian army, and the small amount of oil burning for eight days.

How to play the *Dreidel* Game:

Before each spin, everyone has to put in (candy, or coins, etc.)

The letter facing up when the *dreidel* stops spinning lets you know what to do:
